Brief Overview of the Project

The works involve the strip out of the existing office floors, the formation of an extension to the west end of the site, where the current carpark for the building was, extending the existing building up one floor and undertaking a full office fit-out throughout including creating an ancillary café space.

Progress of Works in October 2022

The hoarding and scaffold are now complete and the scaffold is fully covered in monoflex sheeting. We have installed CCTV cameras around the whole of the site which are monitored when the site is closed. The full demolition of the roof has commenced which will take approx. 4-5 weeks to complete. These noisy works will be undertaken during 8-10 am / 12-2pm / 4-6pm Monday to Friday and from 8am to 1pm on Saturday – as stipulated by Islington Council. Internally we have completed the grit blasting and have now begun to remove all of the existing windows. The ground floor slab to the new Western Extension has also been poured in readiness for the new concrete frame to begin.

Forthcoming Works in November 2022

The demolition of the roof will be ongoing through November and we will have commenced the construction of the new reinforced concrete frame to the Western Extension. Works being carried out internally will be formation of new lift pits, new openings through concrete slabs for service risers.

Site Working Hours

The works will be continue to be undertaken between the hours of 8am and 6pm on Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm on Saturday's.

Environmental Matters

Deliveries and waste away are to be expected everyday between 8am and 6pm. The vehicles will be FORS accredited and drivers are instructed to switch off engines in order to reduce noise and air pollution.

Leroy House is currently collating data and information for the BREEAM assessment which we are working towards. This project is targeting a BREEAM excellent. We are using FSC only Timber, sustainable products throughout the build, reducing energy use/ CO2 emissions and promoting the sites ecology. The site is on track with regarding to our waste target of less than 98% to landfill and to recycle and reuse the remaining. We are also looking to see if we can do some rainwater harvesting on site to use for the construction activities and not use natural resources where we can.
