THE WORKS

Crane works will be carried out to position large steelwork on the roof. This steel will be used to create the foundations of the new story to the existing building.

- That all fixings are tightened by hand to restrict noise.
- Best practice is employed at all times by all the workforce.
- Walkie talkies are used for communication to restrict raised voices.

GOODS HOIST: Electric 1.5 rack and pinion (up to roof level)

ACCESS EQUIPMENT: On the roof Podiums & Peko's will be used.

HAND TOOLS ONLY: There will be no percussive or impact tools to be used on either day

In line with our project sustainability goals part of the steel which is being used has been reclaimed to use on this project. By using reclaimed steel it reduces the consumption, expenses, energy, and time to mine other valuable resources. . For every ton of recycled steel it saves one and a half tons of iron ore, half a ton of coal and a percentage of the water normally used in the production process.
